Wisconsin Act 20 is a law requiring Wisconsin schools to provide early literacy instruction and assessments (4K-3rd grade) to ensure all students can read proficiently by the end of third grade.

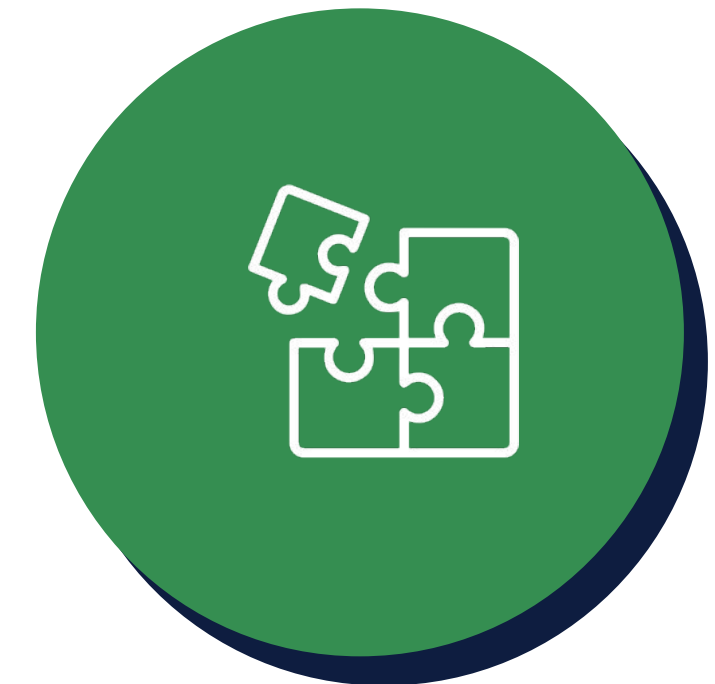

- Any student below the 25%-ile

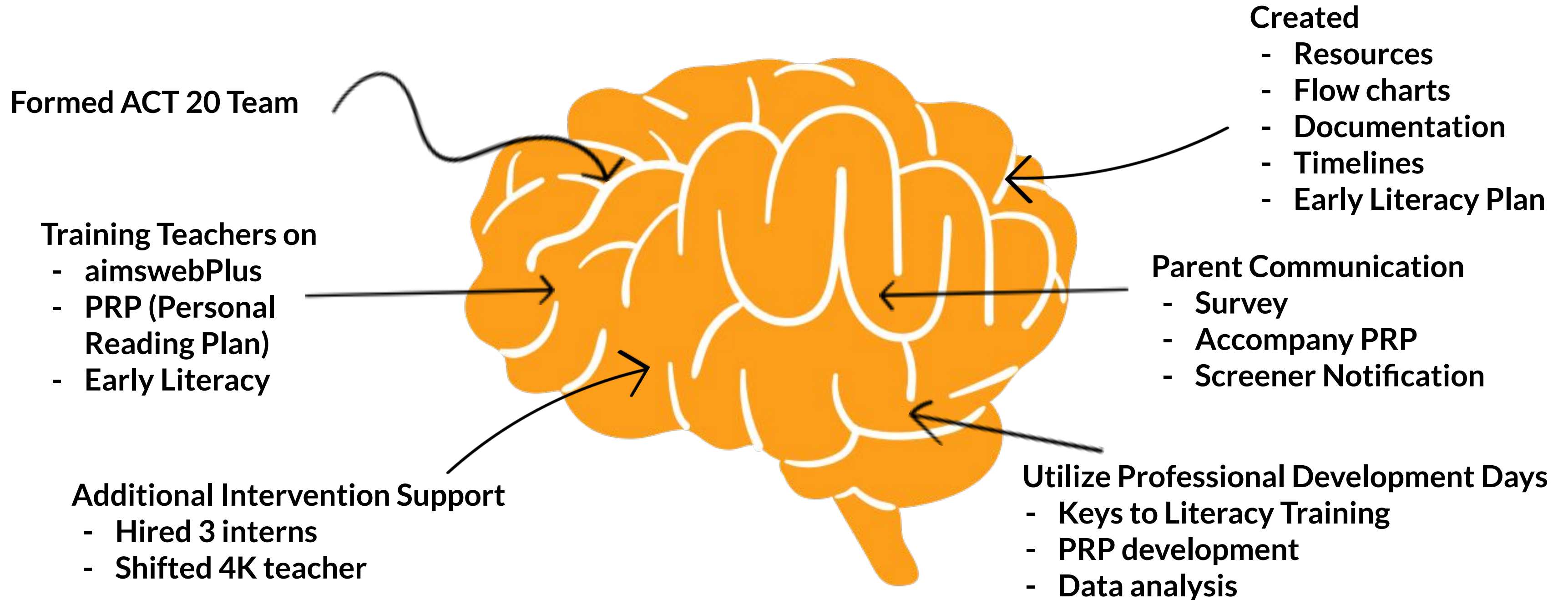
Personal Reading Plan

- ★ Has anyone in the family been diagnosed with dyslexia?



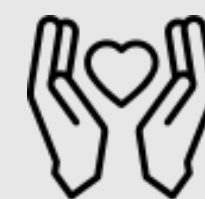
Personal Reading Plan
