## WORK PERMIT INFORMATION

As you may have heard, the Department of Workforce Development's Equal Rights Division has developed a new online work permit application tool. The Division carefully considered the lessons of the past few years, when pandemic restrictions made it nearly impossible for some minors to obtain work permits and decided to pursue an online application that would be available to the parents of minors 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from any computer, tablet, smartphone, or similar device. The application improves accessibility for minors who live in rural or underserved areas and eliminates the difficult logistics involved in working parents having to take off work to make a trip to a work permit office.

Parents can access the site [using these instructions](#). Payment is made directly to the department through the application, using a credit or debit card or by ACH direct withdrawal. Once the permit application process is complete, the Department mails a paper copy of the permit directly to the employer.

## Transcripts

If the post-secondary school you are applying to requests an official transcript, students will send that request via the Parchment website. Please refer to the link <https://www.parchment.com> create an account using a **PERSONAL** email address and order with a credit or debit card. You will select the destination of where you would like the transcript sent. The transcript is then sent directly to that destination electronically. There is no need to pay for a self-view copy as you are able to view your transcript on your dashboard in Parchment. Post-secondary schools will not accept an official transcript when it is provided directly from a student.

**Unofficial Transcripts:** Seniors have access to their *unofficial* transcript in Skyward (Portfolio/attachments). If your post-secondary school accepts an unofficial transcript, you can provide them with a copy. If they will only accept a copy from WHS directly, please contact the Counseling Office.

You can also use the unofficial transcript copy for college visits and for applying for scholarships.
